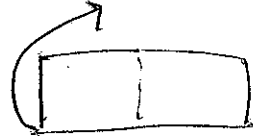
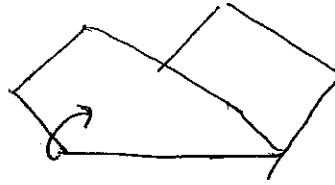


Napkin Hat

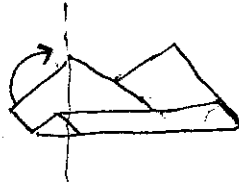
1. Open the napkin so the folded crease is towards you.



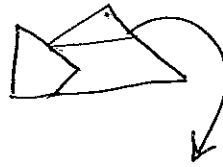
2. Fold the napkin so there are two peaks.



3. Fold bottom half way up.



4. Fold left side over to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the first peak.



5. Lift and drop down second peak.



6. Fold up second peak.



7. Flip the napkin over.

8. Fold over this peak to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the peak.

9. Tuck in second peak.

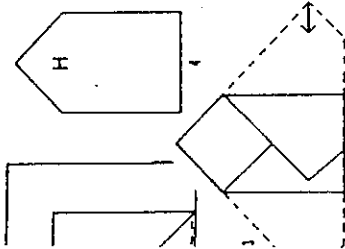
Napkin Folding

General Tips:

Use linen napkins if possible, well starched. For the more complicated folds, 24-inch napkins work best. Practice the folds with newspapers. Children can help. Once they learn the folds, they will have fun!

Shield

This fold is easy. Elegant with Monogram in Corner

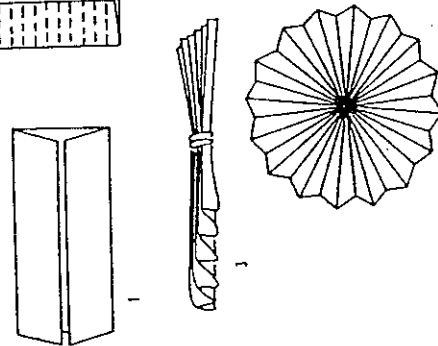


Instructions:

1. Fold into quarter size. If monogrammed, ornate corner should face down.
2. Turn up folded corner three-quarters.
3. Overlap right and left side points.
4. Turn over; adjust sides so that they are even, single point in center.
5. Place point up or down on plate, or left of plate.

Rosette

Elegant on Plate



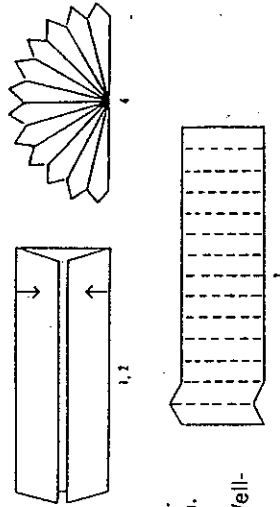
Instructions:

Fold top and bottom edges to the centre, leaving 1/2" opening along the centre. Pleat firmly from the left edge. Sharpen edges with hot iron. Pinch center together. If necessary, use small piece of pipe cleaner to secure and top with single flower. Spread out rosette.

Napkin Folding

Fan

Pretty in Napkin Ring, or Top of Plate.

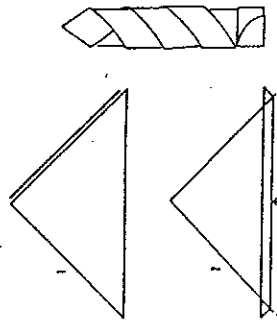


Instructions:

1. Fold top and bottom edges to the centre.
2. Fold top and bottom edges to centre a second time.
3. Pleat firmly from the left edge. Sharpen edges with a hot iron.
4. Spread out fan. Balance flat folds on each side on table. Well-starched napkins will hold the shape.

Candle

Easy to do, can be decorated.

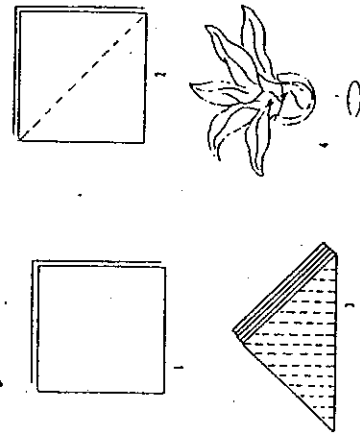


Instructions:

1. Fold into triangle, point at top.
2. Turn lower edge up 1".
3. Turn over, folded edge down.
4. Roll tightly from left to right.
5. Tuck in corner. Stand upright.

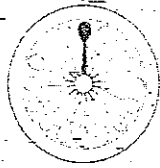
Lily

Effective and Pretty on Table

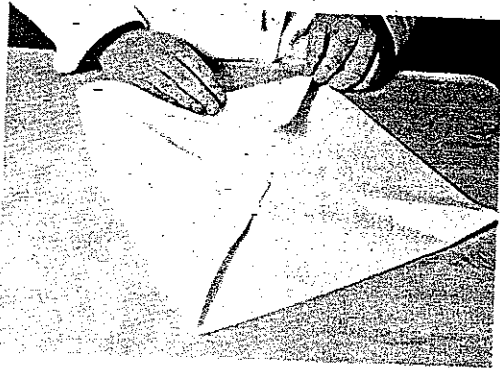


Instructions:

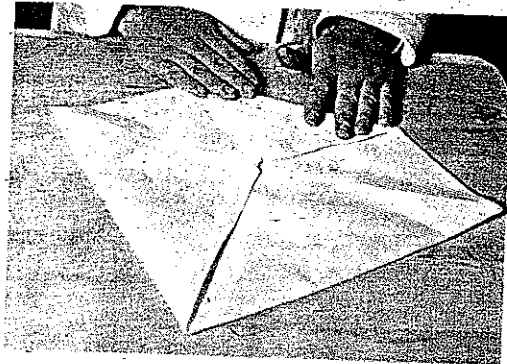
1. Fold napkin in quarters.
2. Fold into triangle, closed corner to open points.
3. Turn two points over to other side. (Two points are on either side of closed point.) Pleat.
4. Place closed end in glass. Pull down two points on each side and shape.



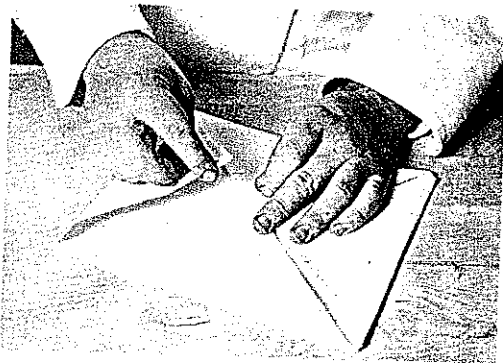
how to fold a napkin water lily



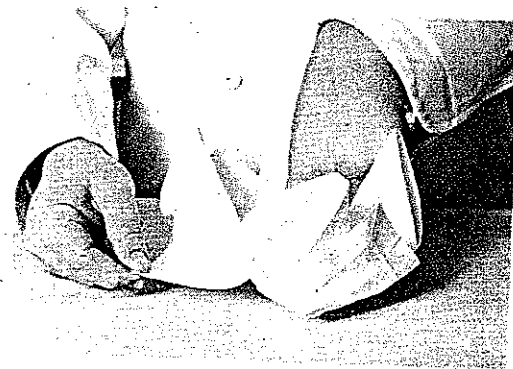
1 The water lily is an attractive variation for napkin treatment. Fold the four corners to the center, making a reduced square. You may iron the edges down to make the napkin easier to work with if you prefer.



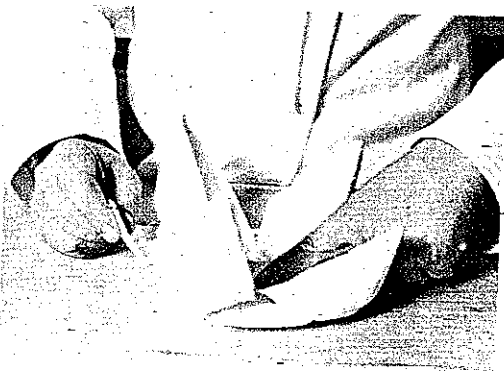
2 Again bring the corners to the center, reducing the square a second time.



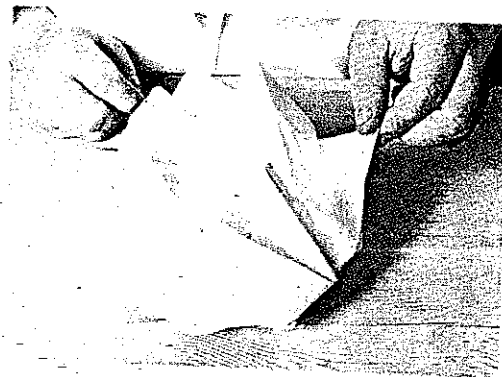
3 Holding the corners at the center, turn the napkin over and bring the corners to the center of the opposite side.



4 Hold the corners firmly at the center with your left hand, reach underneath with your right hand, and pull the folded inner corners one by one around to the top to form peaks.



5 Lock in the peaks by again reaching underneath and pulling out the four single layer corners that remain, working them upward and inward.



6 The water lily is completed. The effect will be softer, as in the picture on the preceding page, if you don't iron the edges down. However, ironing makes the napkin easier to work with at first.
